

Love Is For Ever -- Rediscovering Abba's Fantastic Truths
Please read Deuteronomy 32:3

How can you Exalt, Praise, Declare, Remember, Make mention of, Give Thanks unto, Call upon, Magnify, Reverence, Glorify, or Bless the Name of the Father if you don't know what it is?

There are some that believe that the Name of the Almighty represents His character and that whenever His Name is mentioned that the penmen of Scripture were referring to His character. Brethren, His Law represents His character, not His Name. As you read these few commands (there are many more) regarding the Name of the Father found in Scripture, you may begin to feel that your knowledge of this truth is very inadequate. As His created beings, there is certain homage that we owe even to the very Name of deity. In this study you will find very few of our words. The evidence in Scripture supports itself.

Paul, quoting **Psalm 22:22** understood this truth: *Saying, I will declare Thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto Thee.* **Hebrews 2:12**

But David was the Sacred Name's greatest champion. *I will extol Thee, my Elohim, O king; and I will bless Thy name for ever and ever.*

Every day will I bless Thee; and I will praise Thy name for ever and ever.

Great is YHVH, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable. **Psalm 145:1-3**

O sing unto YHVH a new song: sing unto YHVH, all the earth.

Sing unto YHVH, bless His name; show forth His salvation from day to day.

I will praise YHVH according to His righteousness: and will sing praise to the name of YHVH Most High, **Psalm 7:17**. (See also **Psalm 135:1-3**, and **148:12-13**)

O magnify YHVH with me, and let us exalt His name together. **Psalm 34:3**

I will make Thy name to be remembered in all generations: therefore shall the people praise Thee for ever and ever. **Psalm 45:17**

Teach me Thy way, O YHVH; I will walk in Thy truth: unite my heart to fear Thy name. I will praise Thee, O Sovereign my Mighty One, with all my heart: and I will glorify Thy name for evermore. **Psalm 86:11-12**

Know ye that YHVH He is Almighty: it is He that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are His people, and the sheep of His pasture.

Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise: be thankful unto Him, and bless His name. For YHVH is good; His mercy is everlasting; and His truth endureth to all generations. **Psalm 100:3-5**

Bless YHVH, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless His holy name. **Psalm 103:1** (See also **Psalm 145:21**)

Save us, O YHVH our Mighty One, and gather us from among the heathen, to give thanks unto Thy holy name, and to triumph in Thy praise.

Blessed be YHVH Almighty of Israel from everlasting to everlasting: and let all the people say, Amen. Praise ye YHVH. **Psalm 106:47-48**

Praise ye YHVH. Praise, O ye servants of YHVH, praise the name of YHVH.

Blessed be the name of YHVH from this time forth and for evermore.

From the rising of the sun unto the going down of the same YHVH's name is to be praised. **Psalm 113:1-3**

Indeed, David loved and proclaimed the Name of his Creator, but this devotion is not lost on David alone, but is a theme found throughout Scripture to the exclusion of the names of pagan deities which were not to cross the lips of the righteous....

*And in all things that I have said unto you be circumspect: and make no mention of the name of other gods, neither let it be heard out of thy mouth. **Exodus 23:13***

Be ye therefore very courageous to keep and to do all that is written in the book of the law of Moses, that ye turn not aside therefrom to the right hand or to the left;
That ye come not among these nations, these that remain among you; neither make mention of the name of their gods, nor cause to swear by them, neither serve them, nor bow yourselves unto them:
But cleave unto YHVH your Mighty One, as ye have done unto this day. **Joshua 23:6-8**

*O give thanks unto YHVH; for He is good; for His mercy endureth for ever.
And say ye, Save us, O Mighty One of our salvation, and gather us together, and deliver us from the heathen, that we may give thanks to Thy holy name, and glory in thy praise. **I Chronicles 16:34-35***

... Stand up and bless YHVH your Mighty One for ever and ever: and blessed be Thy glorious name, which is exalted above all blessing and praise. **Nehemiah 9:5**

*Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of YHVH our Mighty One. **Psalms 20:7***

And in that day shall ye say, Praise YHVH, call upon His name, declare His doings among the people, make mention that His name is exalted. **Isaiah 12:4**

*O YHVH, Thou art my Mighty One; I will exalt Thee, I will praise Thy name; for Thou hast done wonderful things; Thy counsels of old are faithfulness and truth. **Isaiah 25:1***

This one is a red letter text, Messiah's own Words: O righteous Father, the world hath not known Thee: but I have known Thee, and these have known that Thou hast sent Me.
And I have declared unto them Thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith Thou hast loved Me may be in them, and I in them, **John 17:25-26**.

[Note: Messiah was a Torah observant feast keeper who came to restore the right use of His Father's Name.]

*By Him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to YHVH continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name. **Hebrews 13:15***

This next passage is prophetic of the end time: And ye shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied, and praise the name of YHVH your Mighty One, that hath dealt wondrously with you: and My people shall never be ashamed.
And ye shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, and that I am YHVH your Mighty One, and none else: and My people shall never be ashamed.
And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out My Spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:
And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out My Spirit.
And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke.
The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of YHVH come.
And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of YHVH shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as YHVH hath said, and in the remnant whom YHVH shall call. **Joel 2:26-32**

*I am Yahuwah: that is My name: and My glory will I not give to another [name], neither My praise to graven images. **Isaiah 42:8***

The Father has only one Name, not a name in every language, **Zechariah 14:9**. Each place in Scripture where you find LORD or GOD (in all caps), there has been a theft. The translators have stolen His Name. The Father's Name is YHVH, pronounced *Yahūwah*. He told us not to call Him Lord (**Hosea 2:16**). He said that we have forgotten His Name for Ba'al (**Jeremiah 23:27**), which means Lord. And "God" is the name of a druid sun deity. Is it so hard just to call Him by His REAL Name?
